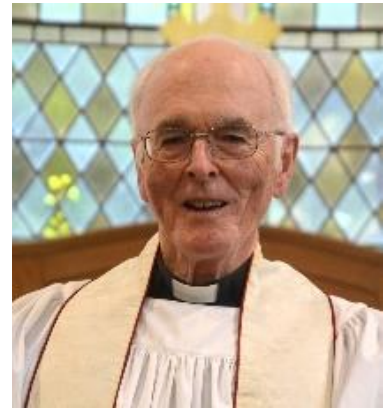


Keith Denerley
